#### 1. SUBSTITUTES AND APOLOGIES

Apologies for absence were received from Councillor Mrs M Barrett.

#### 2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Miss A Owen and Mr T Regester declared that they were Babergh District Councillors.

#### 3. DECLARATIONS OF GIFTS & HOSPITALITY

No gifts or hospitality were declared.

### 4. REQUESTS FOR DISPENSATION

No requests for dispensation had been received.

#### 5. MINUTES

#### **RESOLVED**

That the minutes of the meeting of the Finance Committee held on 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2023 be confirmed as an accurate record and signed by the Chairman.

#### 6. ACTIONS FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES

There were no outstanding actions and the RFO confirmed that grant payments had now been made.

### 7. APPROVAL OF BANK PAYMENTS FOR SEPTEMBER 2023

The list of bank payments in excess of £500 and direct debit payments for September 2023 was presented to members for their approval (copy of the reports shown at minute page 643).

Finance Committee 7<sup>th</sup> November 2023

#### **RESOLVED**

That members approved all listed payments over £500 and all direct debit payments for September 2023.

### 8. REVIEW OF INCOME AND EXPENDITURE REPORTS FOR SEPTEMBER 2023

Members reviewed and discussed the detailed income and expenditure reports for the period 1st to 30th September 2023, as shown at minute page 646.

#### **RESOLVED**

That the Income and Expenditure reports for September be noted.

#### 9. WRITE OFF OF MISSING SHOP STOCK

The RFO explained that during the quarter 2 stocktake it had been identified that a small number of gift cards were missing to the value of £10.40 which would need to be written off against current stock. The RFO also stated that changes were being made to Financial Regulations which would permit the Town Clerk to write off small losses without the need to be provided by the Finance Committee in future.

#### **RESOLVED**

That members approved the write off of £10.40 from shop stock.

### 10. LEGACY FROM THE WEIR ESTATE

The Town Clerk explained that the estate of the late Mr Weir had now been finalised and that the Town Council had received an additional sum of £17,226.98 as beneficiaries of that estate.

#### **RESOLVED**

To note that the additional Weir legacy had been received and would be held in the current year fund until such time as the Council decides where the funds should be allocated.

#### 10. REVIEW OF THE DRAFT BUDGET FOR FY 2024-2025

The Town Clerk presented the amended version 2 of the draft budget for financial year 2024-2025 that he and the RFO had revised since the previous meeting. The staff salary increase for 2023/2024 had now been confirmed by NALC as a flat increase of £1,925 for all spinal column points up to 43. A further estimate of 6% had been included for the staff pay increase in 2024/2025. An assumption of a 5% increase in the precept remained and earmarked reserve allocations had been made based on the estimated funds required in the longer term. At this point the calculation showed an overspend of about £44,500 in FY 2024-2025. This amended draft budget was saved as version 2.0 in the precept file.

#### **RESOLVED**

That the amended version 2.0 of draft budget for FY 2024-2025 be taken forward for the next stage of budget development. This would be reviewed again by the Finance Committee in December.



That the Town Clerk and RFO generate a forecast of outturn to estimate the budget position at the end of the current financial year and present this at the next meeting.

At 8:25pm it was resolved to grant a 60-minute extension for the meeting to run on to 9:30pm.

### 12. REVIEW OF THE DRAFT SALARY BUDGET FOR FY 2024-2025

The Town Clerk recommended that members vote to exclude the public in order to resume the discussion of the details of the salary budget under item 12.

#### **RESOLVED**

That pursuant to the Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings) Act 1960 s.1(2), the public be excluded from the meeting for the business specified in item 12 as the publicity would be prejudicial to the public interest by reason of the confidential nature of the business to be transacted.

### **REVIEW BUDGET FOR FY2023-24 (CONTINUED)**

The Town Clerk advised that in line with Financial Regulations 4.4, members were required to review the salary budget for FY 2023-2024. The salary budget was presented and discussed.

#### **RESOLVED**

To note that the draft salary budget for FY 2024-2025 had been updated to reflect recent changes in staff but that funding had not been cut ahead of any restructuring that might be approved in the near future.

To work through the details of any changes recommended by the HR Committee at the next meeting of the Finance Committee in December.

# 13. UPDATE ON FINANCIAL MATTERS BY THE TOWN CLERK AND RFO

The RFO stated that Councillor Younger had completed the quarter 3 Internal Control Report which had been published on the Town Council's website.

The Town Clerk stated that the NatWest 95-day notice account had now been opened and £200,000 invested at 4.25% interest. The Town Clerk suggested that he and the RFO review the anticipated expenditure up to the end of the financial year and any surplus funds that were not likely to be required be invested in the new NatWest 95-day account. If funds were required at shorter notice, they could be taken from the Lloyds 32-day account. No additional authority would be required as Financial Regulation 5.5c allowed the Town Clerk to transfer funds within the Council's banking arrangements up to the sum of £200,000.
