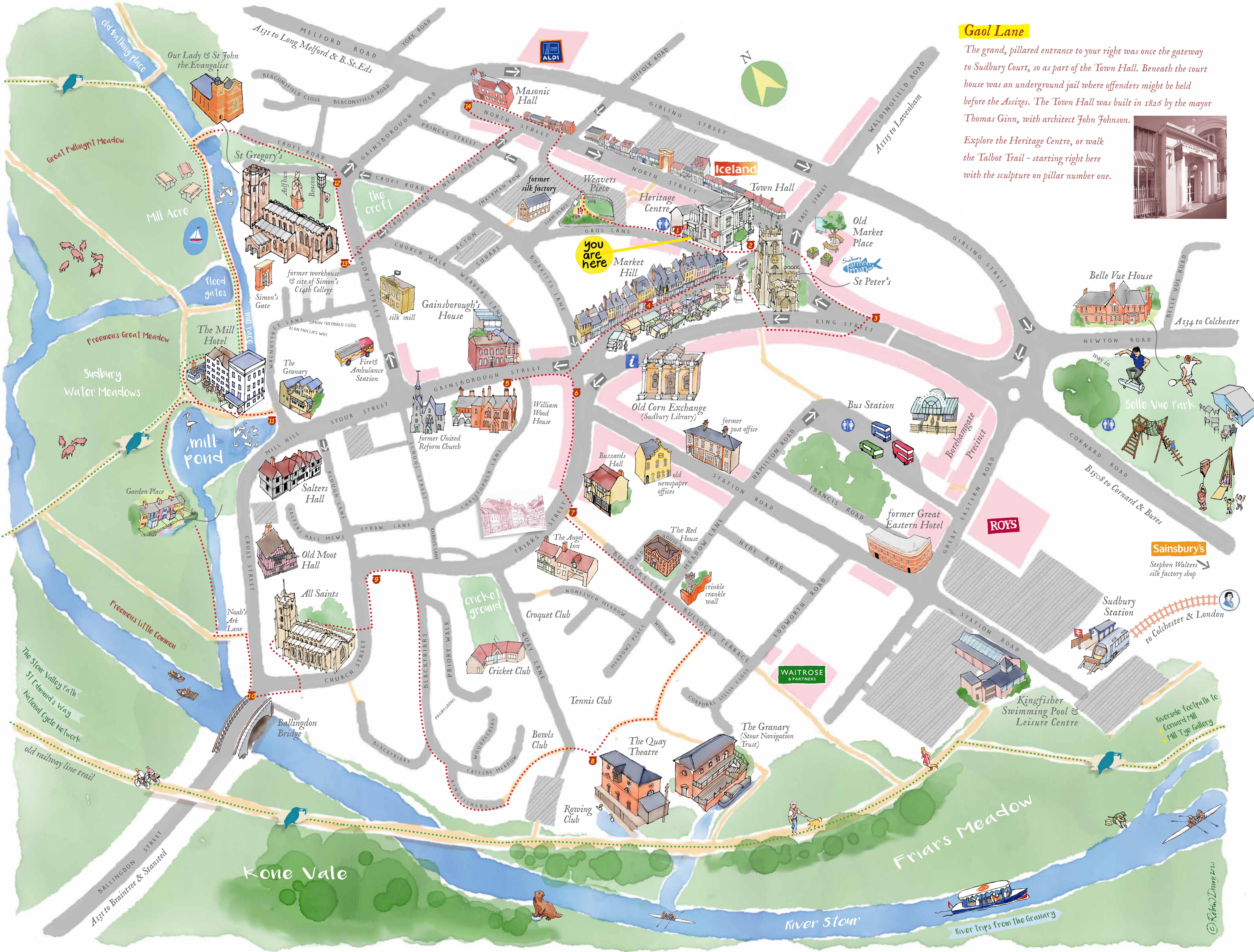




Sudbury ancient market town

The grand, pillared entrance to your right was once the gateway to Sudbury Court, so as part of the Town Hall. Beneath the court house was an underground jail where offenders might be held before the Assizes. The Town Hall was built in 1826 by the mayor Thomas Ginn, with architect John Johnson.

Explore the Heritage Centre, or walk the Talbot Trail - starting right here with the sculpture on pillar number one.
